




BLAŽUJ TEMPORARY RECEPTION CENTRE SITE PROFILE, SEPTEMBER 2023



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CCCM CENTRE MANAGEMENT AND COORDINATION

- ✓ The center is managed and coordinated by SFA/IOM.
- Weekly Interagency Coordination meetings organized by IOM are held regularly.
- ✓ The weekly Community Representative Council meeting is held regularly ensuring the centre's population participation in the overall management.
- ✓ Feedback, Complaint and Suggestion mechanism with supporting forms is in place.
- The centre's Info point is operational providing updated information on the available services in the centre and providing pre-registration upon arrival in the centre.
- ✓ Interpreters for Arabic, Persian, Dari, French, Pashtu, Urdu and Spanish provided by IOM and partner organizations i the center.
- Transport service is provided by IOM.



NFI SHELTER & NFIs

- ✓ IOM distributes NFIs (non-food items), including clothes, hygiene products, and bedding set to all new arrivals.
- Distribution of modern contraceptives and dignity kits is covered by UNFPA.
- ✓ Isolation and quarantine areas are established to corespond to COVID-19 outbreak by IOM, as instructed by Public Health Institute of Sarajevo Canton
- For newly arrived beneficiaries AISA is issued by SFA, registration/preregistration is provided prior to accommodation by IOM.
- ✓ Shelter is provided and monitored by IOM on a daily basis.
- ✓ Wi-Fi access is provided by IOM.



HEALTH

- The center has on site clinic and primary health care is provided by Public Health Centres, supported and coordinated by DRC/MdM/RCSBiH.
- Mental Health and Psychosocial Support (MHPSS) is provided by IOM and DRC/MdM.
- Referrals to specialized care and medications are provided by DRC.
 Medical transportation is provided by IOM, and escort by DRC.
- DRC Medical Team is providing the assistance for daily COVID-19 screenings for centres population.
- ✓ SRH services, referrals for specialized urological care, COVID-19 health awareness workshops are provided by UNFPA.



SAFETY & SECURITY

- ✓ Access control 24/7 is provided by DCPB.
- ✓ IOM established safe room for the staff working within the centre.
- ✓ CCTV expanded to cover entire premises provided by IOM.



PROTECTION

- ✓ IOM staff provides information and referrals related to protection 24/7.
- ✓ Information on access to asylum, identification of persons in need of international protection, counselling and representation is provided by UNHCR/Vaša Prava BiH.
- GBV and PSS case management, empowerment support and referrals for essential services to GBV survivors and persons at risk provided by UNFPA;
- ✓ Community based Protection, Protection monitoring and referral to other services is provided by IOM/DRC.
- Psychosocial support, GBV prevention and response, assistance to survivors and persons at risk of GBV is provided by UNHCR/BHWI.
- ✓ Identification of UASC, protection information sharing, provision of PSS, referral to existing services, relocation to other safe accommodation and escort is provided by SCI.
- ✓ Assisted Voluntary Return and Reintegration (AVRR) provided by IOM.





FOOD & NUTRITION

- ✓ Three meals a day, iftar, suhoor and two fruit snacks are prepared and delivered by IOM/Pomozi.ba, ensuring sufficient daily calories intake and nutritional balance.
- ✓ Special dietary needs are taken into account (diabetic, vegetarian, gluten-free, dieting menus).
- ✓ Open kitchen area is established by IOM for preparation of national dishes.



WATER, SANITATION & HYGIENE

- ✓ The center has 80 toilets and 90 showers.
- ✓ Isolation area has 20 toilets and 20 showers.
- ✓ Gender separated facilities.
- ✓ Maintenance and cleaning services are provided by IOM.
- ✓ IOM took extra measures to ensure increased hygiene practices, disinfection dispensers were put in several spots.
- ✓ Toilet for people with disabilities is provided by IOM.
- ✓ Laundry service is provided by IOM.



EDUCATION & LEISURE

- Educational, occupational, recreational, vocational and sport activities for the centre's population are provided by World Vision BiH, UNICEF, UNHCR/BHWI, SCI and IOM.
- Empowerment Boys on the Move sessions at the Boys and Young Men Centre including life-skills, awareness raising, and preventive activities are provided by UNFPA.
- ✓ The "Barber Shop" service is provided by IOM.
 ✓ Social Corner is provided by Caritas BiH/IOM.
- Sewing, knitting and creative workshops for migrants organized by IOM.
